

Four World Coffee Championships Come to World of Coffee Athens This June

MARCH 9, 2023 — An expected 140 national champions from all over the globe will gather at the Athens World Coffee Championships (WCCs) in the hope of claiming the title of world champion in one of the four skills-based competitions hosted at World of Coffee Athens, June 21-24.

The WCCs take place annually and are the culmination of local and regional events hosted by sanctioned Competition Bodies from around the world. Thousands of fans will cheer on their representatives in the World Barista Championship, World Brewers Cup, World Cup Tasters Championship, and Cezve/Ibrik Championship in-person at World of Coffee Athens; online by following the competition live streams at athens.wcc.coffee, or by watching performances on the WCC YouTube channel. The coveted title of World Coffee Champion can be a pathway to global coffee fame, with winners going on to run globally-renowned coffee businesses and ventures.

This year's World Barista Championship (WBC) and World Brewer Cup (WBrC) are especially exciting as several format changes have been introduced, as overseen by the Competitions Strategic Committee—a volunteer leadership group tasked with developing strategic initiatives that support the competitions community and keeping the WCCs moving forward.

At the WBrC, these include changes to evaluation criteria to refocus on evaluating a competitor's coffee brewing skills, and the introduction of a semi-finals round. At the WBC, competitors can now prepare their milk beverage course using plant-based beverages or other animals' milk, and can brew their espresso using a range of group head temperatures. The WBC updates introduce two new types of scoring scales, which along with the updated WBrC evaluation criteria, better align with where our coffee value assessment systems are headed.

Between competitors, there's a chance to sample international specialty roasters at the WCC Coffee Bars. Registration for World of Coffee opens soon, with volunteer registration now available. If you can't make it to Athens, stream the event from athens.wcc.coffee, catch up with video content on the WCC YouTube and social channels, and cheer along with the hashtag #AthensWCC.
