Registration is Now Open for the 2020 World of Coffee Trade Show in Warsaw, Poland

January 15, 2020— Visitor registration is now open for the 2020 World of Coffee trade show taking place June 18-20 at the PTAK Warsaw Expo in the Polish capital.
